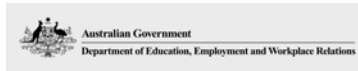

Apprenticeships for the Floor Covering Industry

Due to a significant shortage of skilled workers and new entrants into the floor covering and finishing industry, it has been recognised by both the industry and the government that action needs to be taken to start to resolve the problem.

With this in mind, TABMA is committed to and will be focusing on marketing and promoting the industry to recruit apprentices to undertake a ***Certificate III in Floor Covering and Finishing Apprenticeship***.

However to do this, we need support from you! Don't worry, it's not too hard. All we are asking is that you list your positions vacant (for apprentices) with us and be able to provide a safe workplace and on the job training. You will also need to allow the new apprentice to attend training, and pay our weekly invoice to cover the agreed hourly rate. It's that simple.

What do we do? We handle all the paperwork (including government paperwork) associated with the New Apprentice. We arrange the training with the appropriate Registered Training Organisation (TAFE) and take care of the administration and payroll requirements (inc Group Certificates). We take care of the tool allowance and pay the apprentice while they are on annual leave – no invoice to you for the annual leave period! We handle any workers compensation procedures and paperwork and take on the employment responsibility and risk where you have no long term obligation. We can find the apprentice for you, or if you have someone already selected we can sign them up on our program.

The Certificate III in Floor Covering and Finishing Apprenticeship is a 42 month course, where you can take them on for either part of their course, or from beginning to end. The Apprentice will specialise in either one of four;

- Composite Textile and Resilient (carpet and vinyl)
- Hard Sector (Timber and Cork)
- Resilient (vinyl)
- Textile (carpet)
